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Hurricane Irma Damage: What Caribbean Hotels Are Open?

This tiny French overseas collectivity was hit hard by Hurricane Irma on September 6. As in other places, the hotel scene fared far worse than the island's substantial inventory of private villas. Flights from the airport to St. Maarten, San Juan, and Antigua resumed in mid-October 2017 with Tradewind Aviation, Winair, and St Barth Commuter, as did ferry service to St. Maarten. The island has rebuilt at a remarkable speed; the majority of shops and restaurants and a handful of hotels are fully up and running. The **Manapany** hotel on Anse de Cayes reopened in March after a tip-toe renovation. And the fifth annual **Saint Barth Gourmet Festival** will take return, taking place the first week of November 2018, says Nils Dufau, president of the Territorial Tourism Committee of Saint Barthélemy.
