During each evening, each chef will prepare a four-course menu at a fixed price of 95 euros per person and an eight-course menu at a fixed price of 130 euros per person. Reservations for the festival dinners can be made by directly contacting the festival's partner hotels and restaurants.

In addition to the Chefs' dinners, the festival will include other activities to celebrate the many facets of French gastronomy. These events will be announced in a future release.

Established in 2014, the St. Bart's Gourmet Festival celebrates the art of fine cuisine around the world in the gastronomic capital of the Caribbean. During the four-day festival, Michelin-starred chefs from around the globe are paired with St. Barts most prestigious local chefs to create exclusive, gourmet dining experiences. This year's festival theme is French Gastronomy and will feature eight elite chefs from France. The festival is organized by The Territorial Tourism Committee of Saint Barthélemy.

St. Bart is one of the Caribbean's most varied and upscale islands that features a collection of world class villas, hotels, spas, fine dining and a wide choice of leisure activities including nautical sports and full calendar of cultural events.
